



Vocabulary

Barter: to exchange things for other things instead of for money/ to trade

Cash: money in the form of coins and bills.

Catalog: a book containing a list of things that you can buy, use, etc., and often pictures.

Community: a group of people who live in the same area (such as a city, town, or neighborhood).

Customer: someone who buys goods or services from a business.

Credit: money that a bank or business will allow a person to use and then pay back in the future.

Dry Goods: items that are not food, such as hardware and dishes.

Goods: things that are produced

Gossip: to talk about the private details of other people's lives.

Grocer: someone who sells food and supplies

Groceries: food and supplies sold by a grocer.

Ledger: a book that a business uses to record information about the money it has paid and received, or money owed.

Morse Code: a system of sending messages that uses long and short sounds, flashes of light, or marks to represent letters and numbers.

Produce: fresh fruits and vegetables.

Services: things that people do for others in exchange for money

Tab: to pay for something when using your available credit until the amount runs out.

Telegram: a message that is sent by telegraph.

Telegraph: an old-fashioned system of sending messages over long distances by using wires and electrical signals.
